

## CT+ Creativity Training for Europe

**Creativity Training for Europe (CT+)** is an Erasmus KA2 Strategic Partnerships for Adult Education project, financed by the European Commission (Project Number: 2018-1-ES01-KA204-050065). The project began in September 2018 with a lifespan of 24 months.

The main idea behind the **CT+** project is to support people with talent and creative abilities, mostly those without specific or professional training or degrees, and assist them in utilizing their talents and abilities in the current labour market for their personal and professional growth. Therefore, the project is mainly aimed towards adults in need for up-skilling or re-skilling before entering the labour market.

**Creativity Training for Europe (CT+)** seeks to achieve its objectives through two complementary aspects. Firstly, by offering opportunities for acquiring creative skills in an entrepreneur’s mind-set through the European framework for Creative Training. The framework includes a curriculum methodology and digital contents to be used for peoples’ training. Secondly, it offers a digital environment and community (**CT+ Online Community** <https://creativitytrainingproject.netsons.org/creative-training-community/> ) where people can showcase their work and establish a meeting point for collaboration and entrepreneurship with other professionals or companies that are interested in their services and abilities.

**CT+** is of high importance as it aims to reduce creative peoples’ unemployment levels by offering effective strategies for development of relevant and high-quality skills and competences. The project also promotes entrepreneurship education and social entrepreneurship among people and balances differences between women and men in a creative work environment.

**CT+** is implemented in Spain, the Netherlands, the UK, Italy and Cyprus by the following organisations: Postal 3, Stichting Amsterdam European Mobility, Lancaster and Morecambe College, Euro-Net and Emphasys Centre.
