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


GoDigital Training

GoDigital partner organisations held their short-term training event on the 9-11 March 2021. Unfortunately COVID restrictions prevented travel so the training activity was adjusted for online delivery.

The training is targeted at those working with young people Neither in Employment nor in Education and Training (NEETs). They are among the most vulnerable groups contributing to the high percentage of young unemployed, especially those aged between 18-30 years old.

The event introduced the ideas and activities behind the 4 training modules developed over the course of the project, in order to enable piloting of the GoDigital ACCELERATOR by the partners in the coming months.




GoDigital Training Materials

The second output of the GoDigital project is a set of training materials concerning digital skills necessary to improve employability.

The training is personalized to allow young people to self-evaluate their current skills and, as a result, it will help them to identify and then meet their own training needs.

Training is based on the Digital Competence (DigiComp) Framework for citizens developed by the European Commission. DigiComp offers a tool, based on clear terminology and a conceptual model, to improve citizens' digital competence and harness the potential of digital technologies to innovate education and training practices.



GoDigital Training Modules

Based on employer needs, four domains of digital training have been identified by project partners as being essential for employability. These are:

- Information & Data literacy
- Communication & Collaboration
- Digital content creation
- Safety & Problem Solving

GoDigital training is based on identifying personalized training pathways. Three levels of training activity have been created for each of these domains.

They will be available for use from the GoDigital Web site later in the year.

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Web Site Now Live

The GoDigital Web site has been launched by project partners. It provides relevant information about the project, its partner organizations, the aims and activities, links to the project outputs and latest news.

Once finalized, two main results are expected to be found on the site, a Digital Tools for Work ACCELERATOR and a set of training materials for NEETs.

The ACCELERATOR includes a self-assessment tool which will provide users with a personalised learning path on specific digital tools for employability and digital skills that will allow them to enhance their job prospects. These skills correspond with the EC Digital Competence Framework for citizens.

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
