The third meeting of the project titled: “Entre@VetSchools”, took place in Reykjavík, Iceland between the 27th – 28th of February 2020.

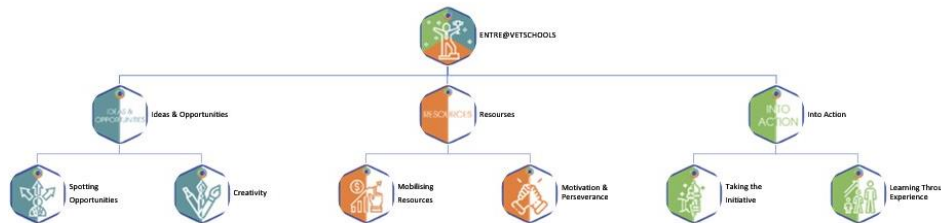
The project highlights the European Commission’s aims to develop entrepreneurial skills that will not only contribute to new business creation, but also to the employability of young people.
