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### **Erasmus Plus project FINE2WORK progress report for January- June 2020**

The main aim of projects is to promote adult entrepreneurial, financial literacy and digital competencies. FINE2WORK international team from Latvia, Portugal, Cyprus and Bulgari is co-creating the teaching materials for adults willing to start own small business or self-employment activities. This is a complex process of various interlinked activities. Firstly, **survey** about adult entrepreneurial, financial literacy and digital competencies was launched in February 2020 to determine training needs for adults willing to start own business, re-enter labor market or do work remotely. Based on this survey results the next step is under development – **framework** of teaching materials. Each partner is responsible for one teaching module development. Emphasys Centre from Cyprus is responsible for module “DIGITAL COMPETENCES”, Project Net from Latvia – module “FINANCIAL LITERACY”, partner from Portugal Descularte and Bulgaria Ruse Chamber of Commerce and Industry are co-developing module “ENTREPRENEURIAL COMPETENCIES”. The framework will introduce the next stage of work – teaching material content creation in English. The partnership is planning to finalize teaching material development by December 2020.
