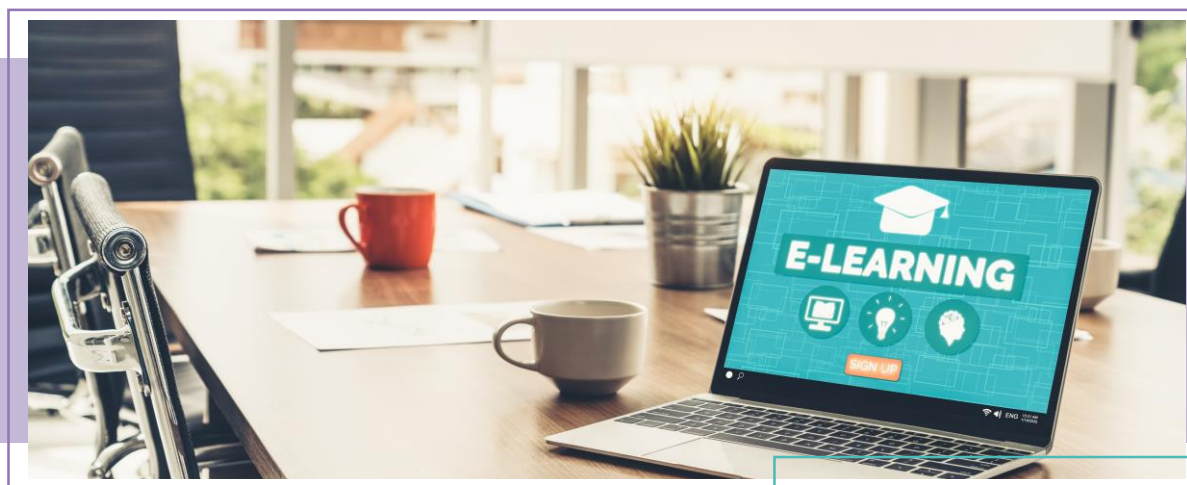




Skills Match

Matchmaking between digital competences gap of adult educators and e-learning offer



What is it about?

Skills Match is an Erasmus+ project in the field of adult education.

Eurocrea Merchant, together with an international consortium of partners from UK, Greece, Cyprus, Spain and Germany, works towards the realisation of an online project matching tool built as an online/mobile application that identifies digital competence gaps and proposes suitable e-learning courses for adult learners.

What is its target?

A common issue among EU countries is the quality, relevance and effectiveness of the training offer targeting adult learners.

Skills Match is built to develop a matching tool for selecting the most appropriate e-learning course, based on identified competence gaps.

Low-skilled, low qualified adults and their educators are the target. So they can respectively develop, upgrade key competences and/or progress towards higher qualifications, and upgrade their skills in order to make their teaching more effective and motivating.



Goals & Strategies

The goals of the project are:

- To increase the demand of e-learning courses
- To improve the quality of e-learning courses on digital
- To produce a matching tool for selecting the most appropriate e-learning course, based on identified competence gaps and a self-assessment tool for digital competences

To achieve such specific objectives, Skills Match will produce the following:

- A Self-assessment tool for digital competences of adult educators built from the DigCompEdu framework.
- An online matching tool



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
